Info: We will have 3 possibilities depending on your interest and fitness level

- Option A: Ride up the mountain with the “Summit Skyride”, enjoy the gorgeous view on top of the mountain and hike down (or the other way around depending on the participants’ preference). Approx. 45 minutes hiking time. Prices: (adults and children) One-Way each \$7.00. Both ways \$12.00.
- Option B: Hike, Bike or Rollerblade around the mountain, approx. 5 miles, 1 ½ - 2 hours. This hike gives you a good work out and is mainly shaded. The majority of the path is concrete and perfect to bring your bicycles or scooters along.
- Option C: Picnic only.

Notes:

Dogs ARE NOT allowed on the hiking trail up and down from the mountain. Dogs ARE allowed on a leash around the mountain. Good footwear is recommended. Alcohol can be brought to the Park, but is not permitted on streets, in parking lots, on attractions, the Laser show, Pavilions, the Special Events Meadow and the Walk-Up Trail. No glass containers are allowed.

Daily park fee per car is \$10.00. You can buy an annual pass for \$40.00.

Program: 09:45 am All members who wish to do option A or option B meet outside of the cable car station “Summit Skyride”. Park at Skyride Lot. See map attached to this e-mail.

12:30 pm Meet at the Pic Nic area between Old Highway 78 and Studdard Street (left from Summit Skyride. There is a parking lot directly next to the picnic area. All members bring their own food and drinks. You are welcome to share a dessert or appetizer. There are plenty of picnic tables. It's a good opportunity to wear your Swiss T-shirts or hats as well. There are mobile toilets at the picnic area.
