

PARK POLICIES & ORDINANCES

PARK HOURS Entrances to the Park are open daily from 5AM - Midnight.
EMERGENCIES (Police, Fire or Medical) Use the Police Call Boxes located throughout the Park, go to any attraction and request the Park Police, or call 770-413-5333 from any telephone.
SPEED LIMIT Obey all posted speed limits. 25 MPH on park roads, and 15 MPH in the Campground, parking lots and near playgrounds. Violators can receive a court citation.
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on streets, parking lots, the Memorial Lawn or any posted area.
PETS No pets other than dogs and cats are allowed. All dogs and cats must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Pets are NOT allowed on the attractions, Memorial Lawn, Songbird Habitat and Trails, Walk-Up Trail, at special events or in posted areas. Pet owners are responsible for the removal of pet waste.
VEHICLE SECURITY Please LOCK YOUR VEHICLE and DO NOT leave valuables inside.

RECREATION INFORMATION

PUBLIC PICNIC AREA Public use tables are available on a first-come, first-served basis in our two designated picnic areas noted on the attractions map with . Public use grills are also available to be shared by several groups. Private grills can be used in the public picnic areas only and may not be placed on picnic tables. Private outside catering is never allowed in Stone Mountain Park. No more than six picnic tables and the immediate area around those tables can be used by a single group. Sound systems of any kind cannot carry sound more than 50 feet from the system per Stone Mountain Park Noise Ordinance 5-109.
WALK-UP TRAIL When climbing the mountain, please stay on the trail marked with a yellow line. If you walk up the mountain and ride down the Skyride, there is no transportation back to the Walk-Up Trail parking lot.
FISHING Georgia Fishing License mandatory (I. D. required). Refer additional questions about fishing to Stone Mountain Park Campground General Store or visit gofishgeorgia.com.
BOATING Boats are allowed during daylight hours only. Boats with motors over 10 HP are not allowed. Boats must have all required safety equipment per state law, including a PFD for every occupant of a boat. Violators can receive a court citation.
BICYCLES Permitted during daylight hours and after dark with proper lights. Bikes must be kept on paved roads and ridden single file on weekends. Georgia Law requires helmets for all riders under age 16.
SEGWAY TOURS AND ELECTRIC BIKE RENTALS Learn to ride a Segway with one of our professional tour guides and glide effortlessly through the park on one of our Adventure Tours. If you enjoy biking and want to explore the park on your own, rent one of our new Electric Bikes. Hourly, half day, and full day rentals are available. To learn more, visit atlantaadventuretours.com.

To ensure you enjoy your experience at Stone Mountain Park, please be aware of the natural terrain. There are some areas which are potentially hazardous. Use caution when approaching such areas as uneven land.
DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS In consideration of other guests, please utilize the Designated Smoking Areas at or near each major attraction. These areas are identified with signage and noted on our attractions map with . Smoking is prohibited inside all buildings, in queue lines, on the attractions and on the Laser Lawn. We appreciate your cooperation.

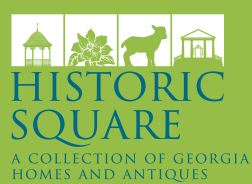

DESCRIPTIONS & LEGEND FOR THE MAP

PARK ATTRACTIONS: Due to the Park's size, there is a separate map and schedule of the Park's paid attractions. This map is available at the Main Ticket Plaza entrance (G-9), at the Summit Skyride Plaza ticket booth (G-8) and at Memorial Hall (G-8). Attractions operate on a seasonal schedule and operating hours vary.

SIGHTS AND RECREATION

- GRIST MILL & COVERED BRIDGE** D-5
The area near the 100-year-old mill and bridge is a great place for picnics.
- QUARRY EXHIBIT** D-6
This outdoor display brings to life the history of the granite industry at Stone Mountain.
- WALK-UP TRAIL & CONFEDERATE HALL HISTORICAL & ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION CENTER** F-14
Visit the interactive exhibit gallery about the geology and ecology of the mountain, view the "Battle for Georgia" film and set out on the 1 mile trail to the top of the mountain.
- HIKING/NATURE TRAILS** D-13
Experience the serenity of Stone Mountain Park on some of our scenic trails. These trails cover approximately 15 miles of beautiful land.
- PLAYGROUND** C-11
The top-notch playground located near the Nature Trail is sure to provide hours of fun for the kids.
- CARILLON** G-5
Enjoy daily concerts from our 732-bell Carillon, originally exhibited at the 1964 World's Fair.
- SONGBIRD HABITAT AND TRAIL** A-10
Site of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Archery and Cycling venue, this area is now a songbird habitat, one mile meadow trail and one mile woods trail with a wide array of plant life and food for a variety of birds.
- THE WATERFRONT** F-6
Segway Tours and Electric Bikes, as well as Paddleboard, Canoe, and Kayak Rentals are all located here.

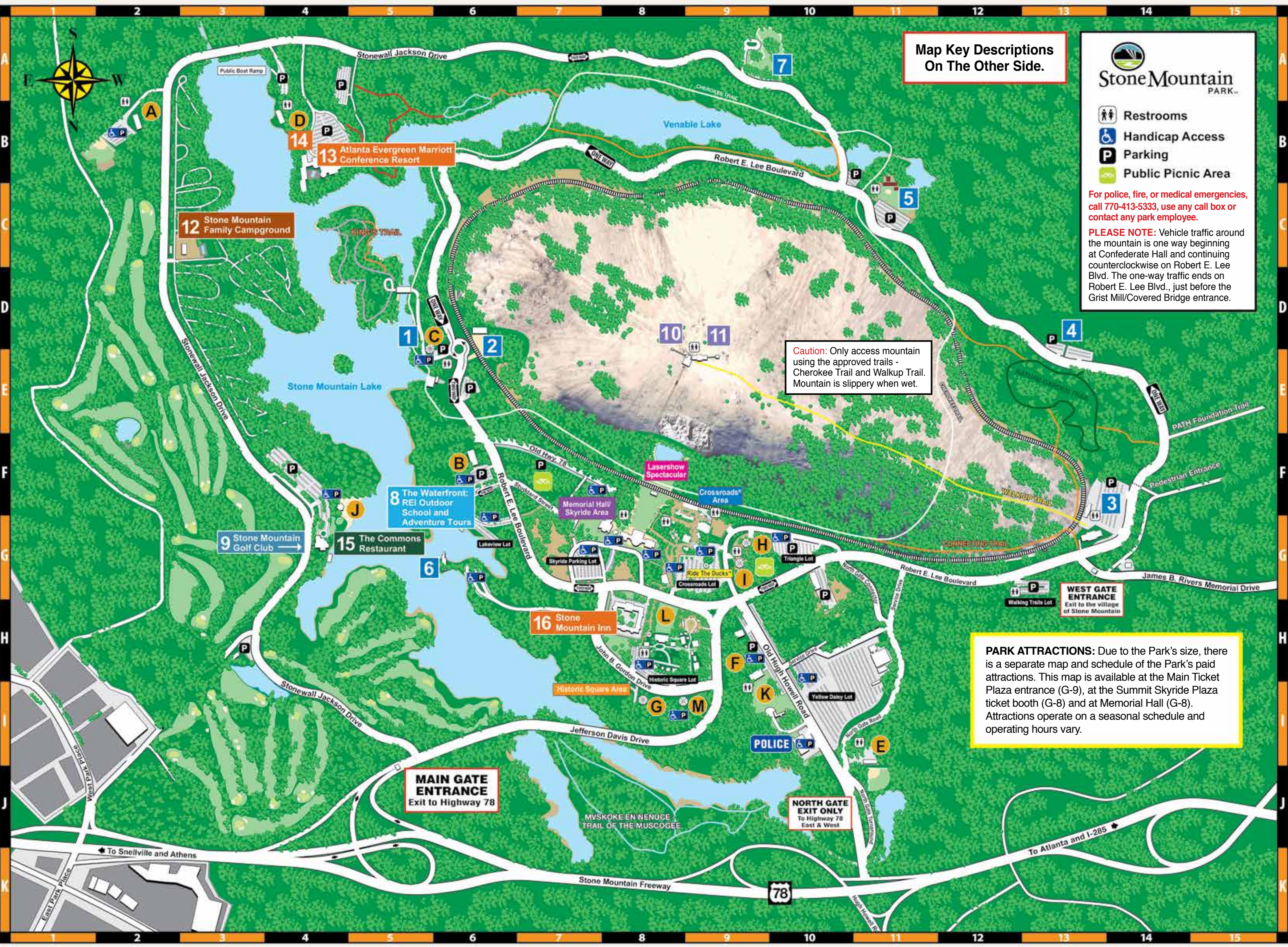

PLEASE NOTE: Vehicle traffic around the mountain is one way beginning at Confederate Hall and continuing counterclockwise on Robert E. Lee Blvd. The one-way traffic ends on Robert E. Lee Blvd., just before the Grist Mill/Covered Bridge entrance.

Caution: Only access mountain using the approved trails - Cherokee Trail and Walkup Trail. Mountain is slippery when wet.
